Wherever you need to go, our slick polymer surface will guide your boat safely and efficiently.

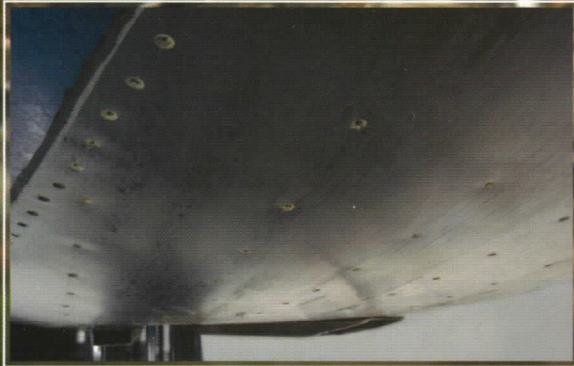
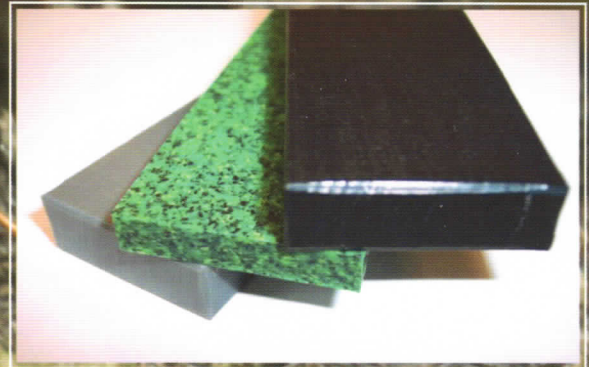
